



NATIONAL REFRIGERANTS SUSTAINABILITY STATEMENT

For over 38 years, National Refrigerants has operated as a global supplier of refrigeration and air conditioning fluids, supporting industry progression in line with evolving environmental standards. In response to the Montreal Protocol, which mandated the phase-out of ozone-depleting substances and led to a global ban on CFCs by 2010, the Company played a key role in facilitating the transition to alternative refrigerants. This shift has contributed to the ongoing recovery of the Antarctic ozone layer, as supported by independent scientific research.

The Company recognises that subsequent generations of refrigerants, including HFCs, present environmental challenges due to their global warming potential. Accordingly, National Refrigerants is focused on supporting the industry's transition toward lower-emission, sustainable refrigerant solutions.

This commitment is delivered through close collaboration with refrigerant manufacturers, wholesalers, OEMs, and end users, ensuring alignment across the value chain. The Company provides access to a comprehensive portfolio of long-term, sustainable refrigerant alternatives, alongside structured engagement programmes, including technical presentations and sustainability briefings.

National Refrigerants remains committed to enabling a managed and responsible transition to next-generation refrigerants, supporting both regulatory compliance and the long-term environmental objectives of its stakeholders.
